ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED BY APRIL 1:

ALL DOGS MUST HAVE A LICENSE AND BE CONFINED TO THE OWNER'S PROPERTY. Owners of dogs found harassing pedestrians; livestock, etc. will be fined. All livestock must be confined to owner's property. Dog license are valid from January 1 to December 31. LICENSE RATES ARE: Male \$8.50 Female \$8.50

Neutered Male \$3.50 Spayed Female \$3.50

ANYONE THAT HAS 4 OR MORE DOGS IS REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A KENNEL LICENSE OR MULTIPLE DOG LICENSE

Multiple Dog License (Up to 12) \$36.50

Owners must present their RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE showing that their dog is vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian, before the dog can be licensed. Jeanne will also need a PHONE NUMBER from each owner for the dog license report sent to the Brown County Clerks Office.
