


- 1. Go to www.wisconsindot.gov



8. This page where the individual's identification is required. Fill this in and click 'Next'.



- 9. On the next page, check "Set all vehicles to this location" [prefilled 'Dodge' 'Kekoskee (V)'], only if applicable.
- 10. Otherwise, select just the individual vehicles that need to be changed.
- 11. Click 'Submit'.



The license plate numbers for the vehicles in the above example have had their plate numbers blanked out for privacy issues. Otherwise, once the individual makes the changes to "Vehicle Kept In" page and submits the information to the DMV the license plate numbers associated with the vehicles(s) will be visible to the owner.
