 - 1. The <u>Village of Kekoskee accepts no liability</u> for accident or injury to participants under this permit.
 - 2. Lawns, park equipment and other <u>park property shall not be damaged</u> through or because of the use of the permitted equipment.
 - 3. <u>Disturbed sod shall be kept to the very minimum</u>, all loose soil shall be replaced under the sod. and sod shall be replaced firmly.
 - 4. All excavated debris shall be removed.
 - 5. <u>During dry weather, sod shall not be disturbed extensively</u> or cut out. Only small probes such as ice picks and small screwdrivers may be used during periods of dry weather.
 - 6. The permitted use shall not interfere with other park activities.

ANY VIOLATION OF THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE CAUSE FOR THE VILLAGE OF KEKOSKEE TO DENY THE PRIVILEGE OF METAL DETECTING ACTIVITY.
