TOWN OF WESTFORD RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-2008 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF POLL WORKERS THAT MAY WORK AT AN ELECTION

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT, pursuant to s.7.32, Wis. Stat., the minimum number of election officials required to work at the polling place during a Town of Westford election is three (3).

However, the clerk may assign additional poll workers if he/she believes they are needed for a given election. The number of poll workers assigned shall always be an odd number.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, pursuant to s.7.30(1)(b), Wis. Stat., the clerk may also appoint one additional inspector who shall serve as a greeter who may answer questions and direct electors to proper locations for registration and voting. This extra person may be appointed without regard to party affiliation and is not counted as one of the regular inspectors. Pursuant to s.7.30(2)(a), Wis Stat., the greeter may also temporarily substitute for an election official who must leave the room during the voting process.
