WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statutes § 287.11 and Wisconsin Administrative Code ch. NR 544 require responsible units to adopt and enforce effective recycling programs; and

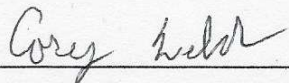
WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Westford has reviewed and considered the **Responsible Unit Recycling Ordinance (Ordinance No. 10/2025-03)**, which establishes recycling requirements and procedures for all residents, businesses, and institutions within the Town; and

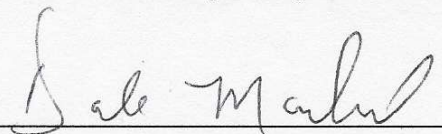
WHEREAS, the Town Board finds that adoption of this ordinance is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Town of Westford;

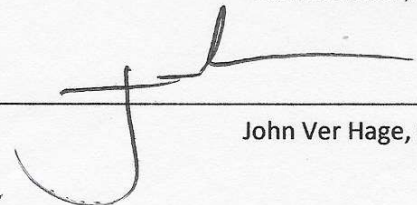
