2023—Construction Complete

The utility construction project is complete in the area of Butler Ave., and near the USPS Post Office on County Rd. A . Finding a resolution for the disconnect of sewer and water serviced through the State’s Winnebago Mental Health Institute was a complicated project. The solution was in accepting CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) funds that covered nearly all of the construction costs resulting in the creation of a new sanitary district.

This small area is now called the Winnebago Area Sanitary District. The Town Board currently serves as the commissioners, but there are willing residents that soon will take over those roles. Finalization of the project is currently being worked on and the official switch will likely happen in late April, May, or June of 2024 after the Public Service Commission (PSC) sets their rate.

Stormwater Management

STORMWATER SMART LAWN CARE



When water from rain, snow, or sleet flows over the ground, it's called "stormwater." Stormwater can pick up debris, litter, fertilizer, and pesticides used for lawn care. And when that stormwater flows into street gutters, storm drains, and downstream, it can pollute rivers, lakes, and streams. Follow these simple pollution solutions to help keep local waterways clean and healthy!



DON'T MOW TOO LOW

Only remove 1/3 of the grass blade height and leave clippings on lawn to allow nutrients to return to the soil—they act as a natural fertilizer!



CAREFUL WITH CHEMICALS

Read the label when applying pesticides and fertilizers, use them sparingly, and avoid applying them to pavement. When there is rain in the forecast, any chemicals you apply can wash downstream.



ONLY RAIN IN THE DRAIN

Don't rake, sweep, or hose debris down the storm drains. Leaves, yard clippings, and trash can clog storm pipes, causing floods and polluted waterways.



CURB YOUR WATER WASTE

Direct sprinklers toward the lawn and away from pavement to save water and keep chemicals and debris out of storm drains. Check out www.epa.gov/watersense for more tips to save water!

Fire Truck Donations

The Town of Oshkosh signed a purchase agreement for a new fire truck in October 2022. The cost of the truck is \$742,800.00. Full payment is not due until the truck is delivered which is estimated to be Dec. 2024 or Jan. 2025. Until then, the town is saving towards that cost. If you are thinking about making a kind donation, choices are:

- Online donation payment is an option at the Town of Oshkosh website.
- Or a written check. Please mail to the town clerk and a receipt will be sent to you.

The donation is tax-deductible.

Home/building address numbers MUST be clearly marked and visible from the road. Our first responders want to find your location quickly if there is a *medical emergency*.

The Town of Oshkosh Uniform Numbering System ordinance Title 6, Chapter 5, regulates standards, mandates compliance, and specifies enforcement.

Other Reminders...

- ⇒ CONCRETE is NEVER allowed in the road right-of-way/ driveway approaches.
- ⇒ Permit is required for new installation and replacements of a driveway culvert.
- ⇒ Disposal of unused items like rubbish, or yard waste in town ditches and road right-of-way is prohibited. Violators may be fined and charged for removal costs.
- ⇒ Permit is required for any disturbance of road right-of-way/ ditches.
