AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CEMENT OR METAL BURIAL
VAULTS TO BE USED IN THE VILLAGE OF MARQUETTE

metal burial vaults shall be used in the Village of Marquette cemetery; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Marquette,
Green Lake County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

That there shall be no burials permitted in the Village of Marquette
cemetery unless either a cement or metal vault is used. There shall be no sub-
stitutions in the matter and it shall apply to all burials.

provided by law.
