## ORDINANCE NO. 2/

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CLEANING OF DITCHES AND ROADWAYS AND CUTTING OF GRASS. - Brush

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient and necessary that an Ordinance be passed so that the grass is cut on vacant lots, roadways and ditches, + Buch and that the ditches shall be cleaned out by the property owners:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF MARQUETTE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

All property owners that own property adjoining streets that are black-topped shall cut the grass on their property and ditches and also the ditches shall be cleaned out. This shall include all property owned either by individuals, partnerships, or corporations. Further, in the event that the property owner does not cut the grass, as is foresaid, or clean the ditches, as foresadd, then the Village shall perform the duty and a charge shall be added to the tax rold and become a lien on the said property. This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and posting, as provided by law.
