

AMENDMENT TO TRAILER ORDINANCE
IN THE VILLAGE OF MARQUETTE,
WISCONSIN.

WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient and necessary that an amendment be had to the trailer ordinance now in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Marquette do ordain as follows:

That mobile home trailers shall be allowed only on the property of bona fide resorts and are located within the Village of Marquette. Within these resorts no trailers shall be parked over 400 feet from the high water mark of Lake Puckaway. Further, said resort owners must be licensed by the Village Board of the Village of Marquette if they wish to have trailers on their resort property.

There shall be an annual fee of \$5.00 per year and the license must be procured and the fee paid prior to July 1st of each and every year.

One trailer shall be allowed on any lot in the Village of Marquette for a period of one year during the construction of a residence. A permit must be secured for this one year from the Village Board and a fee of \$1.00 shall be paid for this permit. The regular trailer fees shall apply to these trailers.

If any trailer fees are not paid to the Village of Marquette and the village attorney has to collect said trailer fees, then the trailer owner must pay the attorney's collection fees.

Trailers shall be on no other property in the Village of Marquette except on the above mentioned resort properties and on the above mentioned one year period while a home is being constructed. If there are any present trailers that are on any property that is not resort property, they may stay due to the fact that they are there prior to this Ordinance. If they are moved they may not be replaced and no other trailer may be brought back.

This Ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and posting as provided by law.
