

ORDINANCE NO. 26

ORDINANCE ON DISCHARGE OF GUNS

*Out*

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette do ordain as follows:

It is hereby prohibited to discharge rifles and shotguns loaded with single balls or slugs, north of 4th Street within the Village boundaries of the Village of Marquette.

PEANLTIES: Any person violating any provision of this ordinance, shall upon conviction therefore forfeit not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$200.00 and the costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the county jail until payment of such forfeiture and the costs of prosecution, but not exceeding thirty days for each violation. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and posting.
