

PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY ORDINANCE

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette do ordain
as follows:

Section 1. 941.01 through 941.35 CRIMES AGAINST PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY ADOPTED. The statutory provisions following the prefix 941 describing and defining crimes against public health and safety in the following enumerated sections of the Wis. Stats., exclusive of any provisions therein relating to the penalties to be imposed or the punishment for violation of said statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this Ordinance.

- 941.01 Negligent operation of vehicle
- 941.10 Negligent handling burning material
- 941.12 Interfering with or failing to assist
in fire fighting
- 941.13 False alarms and interference
- 941.20(1) Reckless use of weapons
- 941.22 Possession of pistol by minor
- 941.23 Carrying concealed weapon
- 941.24 Possession of switch blade
- 941.33 Hazing
- 941.34 Fluoroscopic shoe machines
- 941.35 Emergency telephone calls

Section 2. PENALTIES. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance, shall upon conviction there-
fore forfeit not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$300.00
and the costs of prosecution and in default of payment
of such forfeiture and costs shall be imprisoned in the
county jail until payment of such forfeiture and the costs
of prosecution, but not exceeding thirty days for each
violation. Each day of violation shall constitute a
separate offense.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect Nov.
26th, 1974, after the passage and publication
according to law.
