

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 34

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Green Lake County, Wisconsin, duly assembled at its regular meeting on the 12th of May, 2003, does ordain as follows:

Cemetery Ordinance NO. 34, Paragraph Number 2. In regard to headstones, markers or foot stones, and concrete bases, in the 2nd addition. The ordinance to be amended to read as follows in paragraph 2.:

2. That additional real estate may be purchased from Byron Winchell to allow for expansion of the cemetery. The real estate to be purchased lies adjacent to the east end of the cemetery and is approximately 25 feet by 420 feet in size. This additional real estate shall become part of the cemetery and be treated in all respects as the cemetery except that all headstones, markers or foot stones in block # 27, grave sites # 7, 8, 9, 10, and all grave sites in blocks # 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, and 47 of the 2nd addition are to be set level with the ground so as to permit lawn mowers to readily pass over them. Headstones, markers or foot stones in block # 27, grave sites # 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and all grave sites in blocks # 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, and 26 of the 2nd addition are permitted to be set upright. All such headstones or markers shall be of granite, bronze or suitable stone and must be set into a concrete base, said concrete base to be put into the ground deep enough and with an adequate border to support the size and weight of the headstone or marker, to prevent settling or raising by reason of frost, or grave digging.

This ordinance amendment shall take effect upon passage by a majority of the members-elect of the Village Board and publication as required by law.

Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Burials, Management and Perpetual Care in the Village Cemetery.

1. The price of lots in the Village Cemetery shall be as follows:

\$25.00 for each grave

50.00 for perpetual care for each grave

\$75.00 Total purchase price for each grave

2. That additional real estate may be purchased from Byron Winchell to allow for expansion of the cemetery. The real estate to be purchased lies adjacent to the east end of the cemetery and is approximately 25 feet by 420 feet in size. This additional real estate shall become part of the cemetery and be treated in all respects as the cemetery except that all headstones, markers or footstones are to be set level with the ground so as to permit lawn mowers to readily pass over them. All such headstones or markers shall be of granite, bronze or suitable stone and must be set into a concrete base, said concrete base to be in the ground not less than three feet to prevent settling or raising by reason of frost.
