AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC UPON THE STREETS. ALLEYS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE VILLAGE OF MARQUETTE, WIS.

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

STATE TRAFFIC LAWS ADOPTED. SECTION 2. Speed Limits.

- (a) State Speed Limits Adopted. The proviscens of ss. 346.57, 346.59 of the Wisconsin statutes, relating to the maximum and minimum speed of vehicles are hereby adopted as part of this section as if fully set forth herein.

 SECTION 3. Parking Limitations.
- (a) Parking Limits. When signs are erected in any block giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for longer then the period hereinafter specified at any time except Sundany and Holidays.
- (b) Parking upon the streets within the Village of Marquette shall be parallel with the curb or side of street ex-

wept as otherwise marked by the yellow street lines or signs and the penalty for violation of any of such parking shall

be a forfeiture of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00.

(c) <u>ALL NIGHT PARKING</u>. No person shall park any vehicle upon any business street within the Village of Marquette over an entire night.

The Marshall is hereby authorized and directed to procure, erect and maintain appropriate standard traffic signs, signals and markings conforming to the rules of the state highway commission giving notice of the provisions of sections 2, of this ordinance. Signs shall be erected in such loc-

highway commission giving notice of the provisions of sections 2, of this ordinance. Signs shall be erected in such locations and manner as authorized by the governing body as to give adequate warning to users of the street, alley or highway in question. No provision of said sections shallbe enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

SECTION 5. Penalty.

SECTION 4.

- (a) Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$200.00 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of the forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be imprisioned in the county hail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days, provided that the minimum forfeiture for a violation of any provision of section 2 of this ordinance shall be \$10.00 and the minimum forfeiture for a violation of any provision of section 1 of this ordinance described and defined in ss. 346.61 through 346.64 of the Wisconson statutes shall be \$75.00.
- (b) The provisions of s. 345.16 of the Wisconsin statutes shall apply to adjudications of violation of any provisions of this ordinance.

(c) <u>ALL NIGHT PARKING</u>. No person shall park any vehicle upon any business street within the Village of Marquette over an entire night.

SECTION 4. Erection of Official Traffic Signs and Signals. The Marshall is hereby authorized and directed to procure, erect and maintain appropriate standard traffic signs, signals and markings conforming to the rules of the state highway commission giving notice of the provisions of sections 2, of this ordinance. Signs shall be erected in such locations and manner as authorized by the governing body as to give adequate warning to users of the street, alley or highway in question. No provision of said sections shallbe enforced unless and until such signs are erected and in place and sufficiently legible to be seen by an ordinarily observant person.

SECTION 5. Penalty.

- (a) Any person who shall violate any of the provisoons of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, fprfeit not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$200.00 together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of the forfeiture and costs of prosecution shall be imprisioned in the county hail until said forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding 90 days, provided that the minimum forfeiture for a violation of any provision of section 2 of this ordinance shall be \$10.00 and the minimum forfeiture for a violation of any provision of section 1 of this ordinance described and defined in ss. 346.61 through 346.64 of the Wisconson statutes shall be \$75.00.
- (b) The provisions of s. 345.16 of the Wisconsin statutes shall apply to adjudications of violation of any provisions of this ordinance.

Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All ordinances regulating traffice upon the streets, alleys and highways of the Village of Marquette, Wisconsin, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance heretofore enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Wisconsin are hereby repealed.

Severability. The provisions of this or-SECTION 9. dinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Village Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid and if any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance $\rlap{/}{s}\rlap{/}{q}$ and the application of such provisions to $\rlap{/}{t}\rlap{/}{\phi}$ other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 10. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after ats passage and publicæ tion passed and adopted this 9th day of June, 1958.
