

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF GOLF CARTS WITHIN THE
VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, the operation of a golf cart allowed within the Village boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Green Lake County, Wisconsin, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a golf cart within the Village of Marquette, in violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance.
2. Any person with a valid driver's license shall be allowed to drive or operate a golf cart on Village Streets.
3. Golf carts will be permitted on valid Village streets during daylight hours only, sunrise to sunset.
4. All golf carts must have SLOW MOVING VEHICLE triangle signs on the rear of the cart, and be in proper running order ie: lights, brakes, tires, etc.
5. The maximum speed limit on Village streets is 25 MPH.
6. Golf carts are permitted on all Village streets, except Second Street. No golf carts are allowed to travel on Second Street, (County Road H). However, Second Street can be crossed to access streets on the north and south side of Second Street.
7. No person, owner or person having charge or control of a golf cart shall knowingly authorize or permit any person to drive or operate a golf cart who is incapable, by reason of age, physical or mental disability, or is under the influence of intoxicating liquor, fermented malt beverages, narcotics or other drugs.
8. No person shall drive or operate a golf cart on any private property without the consent or permission of the property owners.
9. No person shall drive or operate a golf cart, which violates the Public Peace and Good Order Ordinance.
 - A. No obstructing streets.
 - B. No loud and unnecessary noise.
 - C. No loitering.
10. All traffic laws must be obeyed.
11. The Village shall not be responsible for injury suffered, because of violation of provisions in this ordinance, or because of violation of traffic laws.
