

An Ordinance Regulating the Number of Class "A" Beer and
Class "A" Liquor Licenses to be Issued in the Village of Marquette

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that limiting the number of Class "A" Beer and Liquor Licenses to be issued in the Village of Marquette, with a population of less than 185 people, and the December 1, 1997 quota of three (3) Class "B" Beer and Liquor Licenses granted to the Village, will promote responsibility of public welfare among a limited number of retail sellers.

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined, that allowing a maximum of six (6) establishments (three bars and three other businesses) to sell beer and four (4) establishments (three bars and one other business) to sell liquor is sufficient to cover the requirements of this Village with a population of less than 185 people.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Green Lake County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. The number of Class "A" Beer Licenses (to sell fermented beverages for OFF premise consumption) will be limited to a maximum number of three (3).
2. The number of Class "A" Liquor Licenses (to sell intoxicating liquors for OFF premise consumption) will be limited to a maximum number of one (1).
3. The license applications will be filed with the Village according to State Statutes.
