

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE SPEED LIMIT ON FOURTH STREET
TO 25 MILES PER HOUR IN THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Marquette deems it necessary to change the speed limit on Fourth Street from 35 miles per hour as an 'outlying district' to 25 miles per hour to be consistent with other streets, except where posted lower;

WHEREAS, it is a lawful purpose of the Village Board to enact ordinances protecting and promoting the general welfare, orderly conduct, health and safety of its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Green Lake County, Wisconsin, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour on the street currently named FOURTH STREET, pursuant to Wis. State Statute 346.57 (Speed Restrictions). This speed limit shall be posted at all times (346.57) (6) (a).

SECTION 2: ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement will be the responsibility of persons with the duty of enforcing the traffic laws of the State of Wisconsin, Green Lake County and Village of Marquette.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting as provided by law.
