ORDINANCE NO. 48

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE VILLAGE OF MARQUETTE, WISCONSIN

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Green Lake County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

- Section 1. Pursuant to section 62.23(2) and (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Marquette, is authorized to prepare and adopt a comprehensive plan as defined in section 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- Section 2. The Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Wisconsin, has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a comprehensive plan as required by section 66.1001(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- Section 3. The plan Commission of the Village of Marquette, by a majority vote of the entire commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Village Board the adoption of the document entitled "Comprehensive Plan of the Village of Marquette", containing all of the elements specified in section 66.1001(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- Section 4. The Village has held a least one public hearing on this ordinance, in compliance with the requirements of section 66.1001(4)(d) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
- Section 5. The Village Board of the Village of Marquette, Wisconsin, does, by enactment of this ordinance, formally adopt the document entitled, "Comprehensive Plan of the Village of Marquette", pursuant to section 66.1001(4)(c) if the Wisconsin Statutes.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the memberselect of the Village Board and publication as required by law.
