## AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 61

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette in session duly begun on the 1/ day of February, 2013, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section One:

Section (c) of Ordinance Number 61, an Ordinance to Prohibit Entry or Presence in Public Buildings While Carrying Firearms, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(c) Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to apply to prohibit a peace officer or armed forces or military personnel armed in the line of duty or any person duly authorized by the County Sheriff to possess a firearm in any public building. Notwithstanding Wis. Stats. §939.22(22), for purposes of this paragraph, peace officer does not include a commission warden who is not a State certified commission warden. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to authorize the carrying of any firearm or dangerous weapon contrary to Wis. Stats. §941.23 or 941.235. Furthermore, this Ordinance does not apply to any firearm training courses which uses only unloaded weapons or nonfunctional weapons which the Village Board approves and allows to be in a Village owned building and this exception only lasts for the duration of a specific course. The person or organization offering said firearm training course must still obtain the permission of the County Sheriff pursuant to Section 941.235 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

In all other respects, Ordinance Number 61 of the Village of Marquette, Wisconsin, remains unchanged.

Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

## ORDINANCE NO. 61

## AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ENTRY OR PRESENCE IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS WHILE CARRYING FIREARMS

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette in session duly begun on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2011, does hereby ordain as follows:

## Firearms in Public Buildings

- (a) Pursuant to Wis. Stats. §943.13(1m)(c)4, no person shall enter or remain in any part of a building owned, occupied or controlled by the State or local governmental unit if the State or local governmental unit has notified the person not to enter or remain in the building while carrying a firearm or a specific type of firearm.
- (b) The Village Clerk shall cause signs to be erected at all entrances to all buildings owned, occupied or under the control of the Village of Marquette providing notice that no person is to enter or remain in any such building while carrying a firearm. Such signs shall be five inches by seven inches or larger.
- (c) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to apply to prohibit a peace officer or armed forces or military personnel armed in the line of duty or any person duly authorized by the Chief of Police to possess a firearm in any public building. Notwithstanding Wis. Stats. §939.22(22), for purposes of this paragraph, peace officer does not include a commission warden who is not a State certified commission warden. Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to authorize the carrying of any firearm or dangerous weapon contrary to Wis. Stats. §941.23 or 941.235.
- (d) Penalty: Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit up to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), together with the costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such forfeiture and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until such forfeiture and costs are paid, but not exceeding six (6) months.
