AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER 8

The Village Board of the Village of Marquette in session duly begun on the 12th day of September, 2005, does ordain as follows:

Section One: Ordinance No. 8 shall be amended to add the following paragraph 4:

Any person or entity who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance, upon conviction, shall forfeit up to \$500.00 together with costs of prosecution and other costs incurred by the Village. In addition to the above said penalty, any person or entity who violates this Ordinance shall reimburse in full the Village of Marquette for the cost of having said person or entity to conform with this Ordinance which includes but is not limited to the cost of removing any trailers, tents or removing any fires or cooking areas in the Village of Marquette. If said person or entity does not pay for the cost of said expense incurred by the Village of abating the problem, the Village may assess said cost against the real estate as a special charge.

Section Two: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
