

CURBSIDE BRUSH PICKUP/ CHIPPING GUIDELINES

These guidelines have been prepared in order to efficiently and effectively provide brush pickup/chipping services for residents of the Village of Spencer. This program is intended for the disposal of residential amounts of limbs/branches that are removed during normal maintenance and upkeep only. Brush is not accepted from surrounding areas.

The Village WILL NOT pick up brush from lot clearing activities or from the removal of trees. Contractor-cleared brush or trees will NOT be picked up. It is the contractor's or resident's responsibility to dispose of this. It can be transported to the Village compost facility, or you may check the Yellow Pages under "tree service."

Brush should be put out to the curb no sooner than 3 days prior to the pickup date. The village crew will limit the amount of time spent at each residence to 10 minutes. If the amount of brush is too great, some may be left for the next pickup date.

The village crew will answer any questions you may have while they are at your residence. If you are unable to speak with the crew, please call the Clerk's Office at 715-659-5423 or the Public Works Department at 715-659-5443 with questions.

SCHEDULE:

- Brush pickup/chipping will occur on the FIRST and THIRD Monday of the month weather permitting.
- All brush must be curbside by <u>7 am</u> on the day of the scheduled chipping or brush pickup. The village crew will not pick up brush in alleys. The crew will not cross or enter private property to pick up brush. Brush that is not curbside by 7 am will not be picked up until the next scheduled pickup date. In order to maintain the schedule, crews WILL NOT return for special pickups. Christmas trees will be picked up starting on the day after Christmas and ending on the last week of January. Christmas trees must be without bags, stands, or wire.

PILING BRUSH:

These guidelines must be followed. If brush piles do not meet these guidelines, the brush/limbs will not be collected until they meet the guidelines.

- Brush must be SECURELY bundled bundles not more than 6 feet long & 6 inches in diameter. Pile brush/branches with the cut
 end toward the road, all in the same direction, and pile as loosely as possible so that brush is easy to handle and pick up. Keep
 brush away from mailboxes, telephone poles, etc.
- Stumps, root balls, roots, rocks, rubbish, construction material, dimensional lumber, or metal WILL NOT be collected.

If there is major storm damage, the village crew will chip brush from storm-damaged trees. The Village Board will determine and announce emergency storm-related brush collections.

Attention to these guidelines is greatly appreciated by both residents, neighbors, and the village crew. These guidelines will keep the Village looking great.

Spencer Compost Facility

The Village Compost Facility is open daily to all residents from 8 am to dusk. You may deposit brush, grass clippings and compost related material. Wood chips and black dirt are available to take for your residence. Fill may be available upon request. The facility is located in the southwest part of the Village on W. Willow Drive, off of S. LaSalle Street.

- Please be aware that this is <u>not a dump</u>. Items such as building materials and 2x4's, appliances, shingles, bricks and other garbage are prohibited.
- If you did not get your orange compost site pass, please stop in the Clerk's Office.

2015 STREET PROJECTS

The Village of Spencer will be conducting several street projects this year. As the summer approaches, street contractors will be working on North LaSalle Street, between Main Street and Elm Street to construct a median strip on both sides of the crossing. This improvement is required to comply with the newly awarded FRA train whistle quiet zone. There will also be crews from the railroad in the area to complete the closure of the Main Street railroad crossing. Please be safe when you travel through these areas.

Street improvements will also be made to W. Willow Drive, the road that leads to the compost facility. The project will involve relocating the existing gravel road and moving it approx. 15 feet to the north. W. Willow will receive blacktop as well. Improvements to this street are TIF eligible, therefore no Levy money will be used to pay for this project. Please be aware that this is the only public access to the compost facility. Temporary closures may occur, so please contact the Clerk's Office before you make any special trips to the compost facility. An effort will be made to accommodate everyone during the street project.
