NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
REGARDING PROPOSED APPROVAL OF LOV-IT BRANDS
SPECIFIC IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (SIP)**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a public hearing will be held on August 19, 2024, at 5:00 pm, at the Town of Bristol Hall, 7747 County Road “N”, Sun Prairie, WI 53590, at a joint meeting of the Town of Bristol Board and Town Plan Commission, concerning a proposed specific implementation plan (SIP), for the parcel of land owned by Lov-It Brands Campus LLC and located along the southeast side of US Highway 151 at the intersection with Twin Lane Road, on the following legally described parcel in the Town of Bristol, Dane County, Wisconsin, under the Town of Bristol Zoning Ordinance:

Part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, and Part of the Southwest Quarter, all in Section 13, Township 9 North, Range 11 East, Town of Bristol, Dane County, Wisconsin; and further described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 13; thence N 89° 30’ 24” E along the South line of said Southwest Quarter, 248.73 feet to a 1” iron pipe located along the east right-of-way line of US Highway 151; thence the following bearings and distances along said east right-of-way line of US Highway 151:

Said parcel contains 4,412,189 square feet (101.290 acres). The Property consists of the following tax parcel numbers: 0911-131-9210-9, 0911-132-9830-8, 0911-133-8000-3, 0911-133-8830-9, 0911-133-9201-8, 0911-133-9230-3 and 0911-133-9500-6.
