Bucket Collections to Benefit Lucia Ramirez

In March of 2025, while in second grade at Sevastopol, Lucia Ramirez was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. After only one month of treatment, her diagnosis was changed from standard risk to high risk, leading to months of intense chemotherapy, steroids, lumbar punctures, and bone marrow tests. She has endured multiple hospitalizations due to infections and dangerously low immune counts.

Currently, Lucia is undergoing 24/7 immunotherapy, which will last until December 9. Then starts the next phase of 2 months of intense chemo and steroid therapy, 5 days a week, with weekly lumbar punctures.

Despite all she has faced, Lucia is fighting with courage and determination, working hard to regain strength so she can enjoy the moments of childhood she so deserves.
