SPLASH PARK RULES

- This Splash Park & Building are NOT a Supervised Area use at your own risk. Multiple security cameras are in use for the overall protection of the property.
- The City of Twin Valley is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- We recommend that children under 12 years of age be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- All participants must conduct themselves in a courteous, safe and family oriented manner. Excessive running, undue roughness, horseplay and other undue disturbances are not allowed.
- Respect the Splash Park—this includes the building, equipment, landscaping, and all things located on the property.
- Do not climb, hang, swing or pull on any of the Splash Pad equipment.
- No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, and/or scooters allowed on Splash
 Pad except strollers, walkers and wheelchairs.
- No glass containers or breakable objects allowed on the Splash Pad.
- Persons with communicable disease or having open sores shall not use the Splash Pad.
- Splash Pad is designed for recreation purposes and not for bathing.
- Footwear/sandals are recommended except street shoes.
- We ask that everyone be responsible for cleaning up any mess made by themselves or the child they are supervising.
- Older children PLEASE be aware of smaller children on the pad.
- Play safe and <u>HAVE FUN!</u>
