RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the plot of the Town of Gilbert, Arkansas (attached hereto as Exhibit A) denotes the presence of Main Street, a dedicated public right-of-way and thoroughfare continuing in a generally easterly direction beyond its intersection with Frost Street, and;

WHEREAS, Colonel Ben Fruehauf, II has erected, maintained, and continues to maintain physical encroachments upon the Town's right-of-way constituting East Main Street and;

WHEREAS, such encroachments deprive the Town and its citizens of the use of this public thoroughfare, and;

WHEREAS, such encroachments have at all times been unauthorized and/or unlawful, and;

WHEREAS, the individual currently maintaining such encroachments has been requested by the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert, to remove said encroachments, and;

WHEREAS, said individual has failed and/or refused to remove said encroachments on Main Street.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of
Gilbert hereby authorizes the filing of appropriate legal action in the Circuit

Court of Searcy County, Arkansas to have the aforementioned encroachments removed and abated from the Town's right-of-way on East Main Street and the individual, Colonel Ben Fruehauf, II be restrained and enjoined from maintaining or erecting any such encroachment on the Town's right-of-way constituting Main Street east of Frost Street to the Point of Beginning.
