

**RESOLUTION NO. 1-2018**

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE UTILIZATION OF CERTAIN PAPER STREETS AND ALLEYWAYS, EXISTING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF GILBERT, AS GREENWAYS.

Whereas the Town of Gilbert has a Number of Platted Streets and Alleyways that are Undeveloped and Otherwise Referred to as Paper Streets;

Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert has Determined that Cedar Street from HWY 333 to Rock Street, "Rock Street" from the Fire Station to Duff, Duff from Church Street to Main Street, School Street from Church Street to Frost Street, and, eventually, Cedar Street from Rock Street to Church Street, could Best be Utilized as Greenways for the Residents of the Town of Gilbert and Others;

Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert intends to Maintain and Enhance said Greenways with Landscaping as well as to Limit Motorized Vehicular Access to Adjoining Residences and Emergency Vehicles only, with the exception of Electric Powered Golf Carts;

Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert adopts Resolution No. 1-2018 Allowing the Utilization of Certain Paper Streets and Alleyways as Greenways.

Whereas said Greenways will Require Brush Removal, Landscaping, and Upkeep;

Whereas there may be Other Areas within the Town of Gilbert to be Enhanced With Landscaping, Including, but not Limited to, the Gilbert Sign and the soon to be Developed Trail Access at the end of Main Street east of Frost Street;

And, Whereas the Establishment of Said Greenways along with Select Landscaping will Enrich the Lives of the Residents of the Town and Friends of Gilbert and make it More Attractive to Tourism, Which is the Lifeblood of the Community;

Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert adopts Resolution No. 3-2018 Amending the Town of Gilbert Budget for 2018. A copy of the Budget as Amended and marked Exhibit "A" is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**RESOLUTION NO. 2-2018**

**A RESOLUTION TO CREATE A POINT OF ACCESS TO THE OLD RAILROAD TRAIL AT THE END OF MAIN STREET EAST OF FROST STREET**

Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert has Decided that Providing a Trail Access to the Old Railroad Trail at the end of Main Street east of Frost Street could be Beneficial to Both the Town of Gilbert and the Buffalo National River Park by alleviating Certain Issues related to Parking at the Trailhead by the Restroom Facilities and Various Other Reasons;

Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert Understands and Accepts that the Buffalo National River Park has its own Protocol in Regards to the Establishment of any Point of Access on Buffalo National River Park Lands;

Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert intends to Comply with the Protocol as Set Forth by the Buffalo National River Park and to Enhance the Town Side of said Trail Access with Non-invasive North American Native Plants Acceptable to the Park;

Whereas the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert will Budget for the Maintenance of said Access;

And, Whereas the Buffalo National River Park Requires a Resolution from the Town of Gilbert Affirming its Commitment to the Creation and Maintenance of Said Access before Proceeding Further;

Therefore, Be it Resolved that the Town Council of the Town of Gilbert hereby Adopts Resolution No. 2-2018 to Create a Point of Access to the Old Railroad Trail at the end of Main Street east of Frost Street and Provide for its Maintenance.
