COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

GENERAL REFERENCES

§ 62-1. Title and purpose.

The title of this chapter is the "Town of Scott Comprehensive Plan Ordinance." The purpose of this chapter is for the Town of Scott, Brown County, Wisconsin to lawfully adopt a Comprehensive Plan in accordance with § 66.1001, Wis. Stats.

§ 62-2. Authority.

The Town Board of the Town of Scott, Brown County, Wisconsin has authority under village powers under § 60.22, Wis. Stats., its power to appoint a Plan Commission under §§ 60.62(4) and 62.23(1), Wis. Stats., and under § 66.1001, Wis. Stats., to adopt this chapter. The Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Scott, Brown County, Wisconsin must be in compliance with § 66.1001(4), Wis. Stats., in order for the Town to adopt this chapter.

§ 62-3. Preparation.

The Comprehensive Plan was prepared by the Brown County Planning Commission in accordance with the contract with the Town of Scott and State of Wisconsin.

§ 62-4. Procedure.

The Town Board of the Town of Scott, Brown County, Wisconsin, by this chapter, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and roll call vote by a majority of the Town Board present and voting, provides the authority for the Town of Scott to adopt its Comprehensive Plan under § 66.1001, Wis. Stats., and provides the authority for the Town Board to order its publication.

§ 62-5. Public notice and input.

The Town Board of the Town of Scott, Brown County, Wisconsin has adopted procedures where several public meetings were held to obtain public input during the development of the Comprehensive Plan, and these meetings included a public visioning session on January 25, 2005, monthly Citizens Advisory Committee meetings and an open house meeting on December 8, 2005, and a public hearing on January 3, 2006.

§ 62-6. Adoption.

The Town Board of the Town of Scott, Brown County, Wisconsin, by the enactment of this chapter formally adopts the document titled "Town of Scott Comprehensive Plan Ordinance" under § 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats. ¹
