**General Ordinance 02-26: Creating Establishing Split Shifts for election
officials for the Town of Scott Code of Ordinance.**

***To create §105 Establishing Split Shifts for Election Officials Ordinance;
authorizing two work shifts for election officials on Election Day and permitting
the Board to appoint a greeter.***

The Town Board of the Town of Scott, Brown County, Wisconsin, has the specific
authority under s. 7.30 (1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a
quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the
selection of 2 sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follows:

- A. There may be 2 shifts for election workers on all election days. Such shifts to be
determined by the Clerk as necessary to meet election worker schedules and election
day demands.
- B. The town board may for each election appoint one additional election inspector to
serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for
registration and voting and shall be available to substitute for other election officials who
must leave the room during the voting process.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80,
Wis. stats.


