




Absentee Ballots Sent out March 9, 2026

Absentee ballots for the April 7, 2026 election were mailed on Monday, March 9, 2026, to Town of Scott residents who requested an absentee ballot.

3 Ways to Return Your Absentee Ballot

- Deliver to the municipal clerk’s office or drop off in our secure drop box.
- Drop off at polling place (2621 Jody Dr) on Election Day
- Mail (We recommend absentee ballots be mailed back by March 28 to ensure they arrive on time).




Questions on who can return your absentee ballot?

- Only you, the voter, can return your absentee ballot.
- If you’re a voter with disabilities, a trusted person may mail or deliver your absentee ballot to a drop-off site or polling place. (Exclusions: Cannot be your employer or union representative.)

Absentee Voters: Triple-Check Your Ballot!

1. **Sign** the return envelope.
2. **Verify** your voter information is correct.
3. **Ensure your witness** signs, and provides their name and *full* address clearly.



Still need to request an absentee ballot?

All voters in Wisconsin can request an absentee ballot be mailed to them by submitting a written request. Voters must be registered before they can request an absentee ballot. Photo ID must also be provided with the absentee request (with some exceptions).

The deadline to request an absentee ballot is Thursday April 2, 2026 at 5 p.m. for regular or temporary overseas voters. The deadline for military or indefinitely confined voters to request an absentee ballot is Friday, April 3, 2026 at 5 p.m.
