Project Overview

The Town of Scott is planning construction improvements along Bay Heights Dr, and Sandpiper Way. The project is intended to: improve pavement condition.

PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

Existing pavement pulverizing, grading, resurfacing, and shouldering.



WHY THIS PROJECT MATTERS

These improvements are being completed to extend the service life of public infrastructure, improve safety and reliability, and reduce future maintenance needs.

ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Local access will be maintained to the extent practical. Temporary driveway restrictions may be necessary when work occurs directly in front of a property. If access must be temporarily limited, the project team will coordinate with affected property owners in advance when practical.

TRAFFIC/PARKING

Follow posted signs, barricades, and flaggers.
Avoid parking in active construction areas during work hours.
Expect changing traffic patterns as work progresses.

What to Expect

DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction noise, dust, vibration, and equipment activity near the work area
Temporary pedestrian, driveway, or roadway access changes.
Short interruptions while crews complete work adjacent to properties.
Restoration work after underground or surface improvements are complete.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

Keep children and pets away from construction equipment and work zones.
Place refuse and recycling containers where they remain visible to collection crews.
Notify the project contact if you have special access needs during construction.
