Dear Residents:

As you know the Board has been evaluating Security within the Village with the goal of enhancing the safety of our residents. At our recent meetings, the Board voted to approve the installation of cameras at each of the Village entrances as well as enhancing our dedicated security patrol in the area. Although this will necessitate some additional cost in our budget, security is an important matter and our Board believes these enhancements will be beneficial to Village residents.

After a thorough review of options and proposals, the Board has chosen to contract with Blue Line Security Patrol for a dedicated "marked" patrol car in our Village. Blue Line has also been selected by the other Villages (Hewlett Neck and Hewlett Bay Park) and while our patrol car will be dedicated to Woodsburgh, we will be coordinating safety protocols among the Villages.

The following are some features of the Village Security.

Each security patrol will have a designated cell phone for the residents to call if needed. This cell number will be provided to the residents in a separate communication.

The security patrol car will be patrolling seven (7) days a week on staggered evenings and overnight shifts.

The two neighboring Villages, Hewlett Bay Park and Hewlett Neck will have their own designated cars, and each car will have a radio that the drivers can communicate with each other.

The cameras will each have license plate reader (LPR) features.

Each Patrol car will have laptop access to the video cameras at the Village entrances to monitor activity.

Thank you for your patience during this process.... We will keep you updated if any matters arise.
