The Town Board of the Town of Taft, Taylor County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.15 (2), Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designated town highways as class "B" highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Taft are designated class "B" highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s.348.16 (2), Wis. Stats., unless increased by town ordinance: Black Top Highway descriptions: Pinewood Dr. from State Hwy 73 to the west 1 mile to School Rd, County Line Rd from State Hwy 73 to the west 3 miles to Meridian Dr., N. Meridian Dr. from County Hwy F to the North 3 miles to County Hwy S.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of this ordinance; the violator shall pay a forfeiture of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1000, plus the applicable surcharges, assessments, and costs for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. In addition, the town board may seek injunctive relief from a court of record to enjoin further violations.

This ordinance is effective on October 17, 2013

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s.60.80, Wis Stats.
