THE TOWN BOARD of the Town of Bayfield, meeting in regular session this 14 day of 198, DO ORDAIN as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1 ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION

TO GOVERN AMBULANCE SERVICE

- 1. There is hereby created a Commission to serve jointly with members thereon from the Town of Russell and the City of Bayfield, which are adopting ordinances similar hereto.
- 2. Membership on the commission shall initially be six (6), two members being from the City of Bayfield, two members from the Town of Bayfield, and two members from the Town of Russell. The members shall be appointed by the respective governing bodies to serve indefinite terms at the pleasure of such governing bodies.
- 3. The Commission shall have the responsibility of overseeing the operation and providing ambulance service to the three municipalities. Such responsibility shall include, but not be limited to the ownership of an ambulance to be housed with the City, and the necessary equipment for providing service. Upon acquisition of such ambulance, the three municipalities shall share the cost thereof equally.
- 4. The Town of Bayfield shall enter into a contract with the Commission, which contract shall extend from January 1, 1988 to December 31, 1988, for the supplying of ambulance service within the Town. Such contract shall provide for renewal thereof unless written notice is given by the municipality.
- 5. The Commission shall annually make an accounting to the municipality. In the event the contract charges have not covered the actual cost of operation, the municipality shall forthwith pay to the Commission the sum of one-third of such deficit.
- 6. Unpaid bills for ambulance service rendered shall not be considered an operating cost to be shared equally by each municipality, but will be billed to and paid by the town or city of orgin after six(6) months.
