ORDINANCE NO. 02-01

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ONE INDIVIDUAL TO SERVE IN THE OFFICE OF TOWN TREASURER

The Town Board of the Town of Bayfield, Bayfield County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

- 1. That pursuant to Wis. Stats. 60.30(1e)(a), the office of Town Treasurer shall be appointed by a majority of the members-elect of the town board, as defined in Wis. Stats. 59.001(2m).
- 2. The term of office for the duties of the Town Treasurer, pursuant to Wis. Stats 60.30(1e)(c) shall be for two years.
- 3. The Town Board will set the salary of the Town Treasurer from time to time.
- 4. The ordinance will take effect after approval of a referendum at the General Election, which will be held not sooner than 45 days after the referendum is called by the town board.
- 5. The term will begin after the expiration of the term of the incumbent officer.
