ORDINANCE 2019-03 ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ORDINANCE

Pursuant to §23.33(8) and (11) Wisconsin Statutes, the Town Board of the Town of Bayfield - Bayfield County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to designate all-terrain vehicle and utility-terrain vehicle (hereinafter "ATV/UTV") routes within the Town of Bayfield and enact regulations for the operation of ATVs/UTVs thereon.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement.

This ordinance shall apply to all town roads within the Town of Bayfield, and shall be enforced by any of those officers authorized to do so under §23.33(12) Wisconsin State Statutes.

Section 3. Designated Routes.

The following portions/lengths of the following town roads within the Town of Bayfield are hereby designated ATV/UTV routes:

- 1. Betzold Road.
- 2. Butterfield Road.
- 3. Connie's Lane.
- 4. Curly Road.
- 5. Eagle Island Road (to NPS Boundary).
- 6. Echo Valley Road.
- 7. Engholm Road.
- 8. Faye Lane.
- 9. Gotchling Road.
- 10. Gravel Pit Road.
- 11. Happy Hollow Road.
- 12. Hatchery Road.
- 13. Henkens Road (Star Route Rd. to McCutcheon Rd.).
- 14. Island View Road.
- 15. Jammer Hill Road.
- 16. Jodi Road (Town of Bayfield portion).
- 17. McCutcheon Road.
- 18. Martin Road.
- 19. Menard Road.
- 20. Meyers-Olson Road.
- 21. Milligan Road.
- 22. Munson Road.
- 23. North Branch Road (to NPS Boundary).

- 24. North Pratt Road.
- 25. Compton Road.
- 26. Sand Point Road (to NPS Boundary).
- 27. Star Route Road (CTH J to Town of Bell Boundary).
- 28. Valley Road.
- 29. Weber Road.
- 30. Whiting Road (to Town of Bayview Boundary).
- 31. Schultz Road.
- 32. Settlement Dump Road.
- 33. Siefert Road.
- 34. South Pratt Road.

Each designated ATV/UTV route shall be marked by signs having reflectorized white ATV/UTV symbols, bordered and with messages on reflectorized green backgrounds with minimum sizes of 24 inches and 18 inches, with directional arrows where appropriate the designated routes and at such locations and intervals as are necessary to enable ATV/UTV operators to follow the routes. A sign shall be placed on Star Route Road at the intersection with Butterfield Road stating "No amenities (gas-food-lodging) beyond this point".

Section 5. Emergency Closures.

The Town Board may take action to temporarily close any designated ATV/UTV route or portion thereof for a specified period of time if the Board determines that a safety or detrimental environmental situation warrants such closure.

Section 6. Operations Restrictions.

Any ATV/UTV being operated on a designated ATV/UTV route shall be operated on the extreme right hand side thereof; shall not exceed a speed of 25 mph; shall display a lighted head lamp and tail lamp at all times during such operation; and shall be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Section 7. Incorporation of Statutes.

The provisions of §23.33 Wisconsin Statutes are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 8. This ordinance supersedes and replaces the All-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance 2013-06 adopted by the Town Board on December 16, 2013, Ordinance 2015-01: Update to the All-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance adopted on May 7th, 2015, and Ordinance 2019-02: Update to All-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance adopted on June 17th, 2019.

Section 9. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication and signage of the designated routes.
