ORDINANCE 2015-01 ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE ORDINANCE

Pursuant to §23.33(8) and (11) Wisconsin Statutes, the Town Board of the Town of Bayfield - Bayfield County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

The purpose of this ordinance is to designate all-terrain vehicle (hereinafter "ATV") routes within the Town of Bayfield and enact regulations for the operation of ATVs thereon.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement.

This ordinance shall apply to all town roads within the Town of Bayfield, and shall be enforced by any of those officers authorized to do so under §23.33(12) Wisconsin State Statutes.

Section 3. Designated Routes.

The following portions/lengths of the following town roads within the Town of Bayfield are hereby designated ATV routes:

- 1. Betzold Road.
- 2. Butterfield Road.
- 3. Echo Valley Road.
- Gotchling Road.
- 5. Gravel Pit Road.
- 6. Hatchery Road.
- 7. Henkens Road (Star Route Rd to McCutcheon Rd)
- 8. Jammer Hill Road.
- 9. McCutcheon Road.
- 10. Menard Road.
- 11. Milligan Road.
- 12. Eagle Island Road (to NPS Boundary).
- 13. North Branch Road (to NPS Boundary).
- 14. Compton Road.
- 15. Sand Point Road (to NPS Boundary).
- 16. Star Route Road (CTH J to Town of Bell Boundary).
- 17. Valley Road.
- 18. Weber Road.
- 19. Torbick Road.
- 20. Meyers-Olson Road.
- 21. Happy Hollow Road.

Each designated ATV route shall be marked by signs having reflectorized white ATV symbols, bordered and with messages on reflectorized green backgrounds with minimum sizes of 24 inches and 18 inches, with directional arrows where appropriate, placed at the beginnings of the designated routes and at such locations and intervals as are necessary to enable ATV operators to follow the routes. A sign shall exist on Star Route Road at the intersection with Butterfield Road stating "No amenities (gas-food-lodging) beyond this point".

Section 5. Emergency Closures.

The Town Board may take action to temporarily close any designated ATV route or portion thereof for a specified period of time if the Board determines that a safety or detrimental environmental situation warrants such closure.

Section 6. Operations Restrictions.

Any ATV being operated on a designated ATV route shall be operated on the extreme right hand side thereof; shall not exceed a speed of 25 mph; shall display a lighted head lamp and tail lamp at all times during such operation; and shall be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Section 7. Incorporation of Statutes.

The provisions of §23.33 Wisconsin Statutes are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 8. This ordinance supersedes and replaces the all-terrain vehicle ordinance 2013-06 adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Bayfield on December 16, 2013.

Section 9. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication and signage of the designated routes.
