ORDINANCE: 2024-01
ESTABLISHING SPLIT SHIFTS FOR
ELECTION WORKERS

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Bayfield, Bayfield County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 7.30 (1), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance, and .

WHEREAS, this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the selection of two sets of officials to work at different times on each election day as follow:

- A. There shall be two shifts for election workers on all election days. The first shift shall commence at 6:30 AM and end at 1:30 PM. The second shift shall commence at 1:30 PM and end with completion of all required election day duties that follow the closure of the polls.
- B. The Town Board shall for each election appoint one additional election inspector

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Bayfield does ordain this ordinance.

This ordinance is effective on publication or posting.


The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.


