Please remember that placing snow or any other material on town roads, streets, sidewalks, parking lots, alleys, or other public rights-of-way is against the law, according to Town Ordinances and State Statutes 346.94 and 941.30. When you are clearing your driveway or sidewalk, kindly make sure to direct all snow away from public areas. Plowing snow across roads is not allowed and can result in fines ranging from \$10.00 to \$100.00, plus court costs for each violation. In the event of injury, felony charges may be considered. Town of Lincoln Recycling Center

Monday through Saturday - 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Town residents may purchase a punch card at the recycling center for garbage drop-off. Looking for curbside pickup? Lottery Credit Reminder

Does your tax bill include a Lottery and Gaming Credit? If not, you might still be eligible. To qualify, you must own a home in Wisconsin and have made it your primary residence on January 1 of the year the tax was assessed. A primary residence is the home where you live for more than six months of the year. If you are temporarily away, the primary residence is the home you return to. If you believe you qualify and your tax bill does not show a Lottery and Gaming Credit, contact your local municipality treasurer.

Dog License Information

The Town of Lincoln requires all dogs over six months old to be licensed starting January 1. License fees are \$5 for spayed or neutered dogs and \$10 for those that are not. To license your dog, you must submit either in person or by mail a copy of your dog's current rabies vaccination record from your veterinarian, along with a separate check payable to the Town of Lincoln for the correct amount. If mailing your information, include a self-addressed, stamped envelope to receive your license and tag.

Applications for Dog Licenses are available on our website or at our town office. Remember, dog licenses always expire on December 31, regardless of when you purchase the license. Please be a responsible pet owner by keeping your dog leashed and/or contained on your property.
