

ODINANCE #04

REGULATING & LICENSING OF PEDDLERS & HAWKERS

An act regulating and licensing peddlers and hawkers.

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, State of Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

1. No person, firms or corporation shall engage in or follow the business or occupation of a hawker or peddler within the said Village of Cochrane without having first obtained a license for that purpose. Every person, firm or corporation desiring to engage in the Village of Cochrane shall be entitled to a license authorizing him to do so upon payment into the Treasury of said Village of Cochrane of a license fee of the sum of Five Dollars per diem.

Before making or offering to make any such sale under the state license every person, firm, or corporation shall exhibit the state license to the Clerk of the said Village of Cochrane and upon payment to said Clerk the local fee hereinafter mentioned said Clerk shall record the state license authorizing sales within the limits of said Village of Cochrane making sale or offering to do so without said license or endorsement shall subject such person to the penalty as he would be liable to if no state license had been issued to such person firm or corporation.
