ODINANCE #06

CIRCUS AND ENTERTAINMENT LICENSE

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, State of Wisconsin, do Ordain as follows:

Every owner, manager, or agent of a caravan, circus, managerie, show, tent show, vandeville, Ferris wheel, merry-go-round, ocean wave, whip or sea plane, caterpillar, butterfly, or any other so called "ride" operated for amusement, before he shall be allowed to exhibit or operate the same within the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, State of Wisconsin, shall procure a license as a public show man by waving application in writing to the clerk of said Village, which application shall state in detail the nature and character of the exhibition, and seating capacity of the equipment, and shall pay or cause to be paid to said clerk to following license fee: - for equipment with a seating capacity of less than 100 the sum of three dollars (\$3.00), for equipment with a seating capacity of over 100 but less than 200 the sum of five dollars (\$5.00), and for equipment with seating capacity exceeding 200 the sum of eight dollars (\$8.00). Upon the filing of an application for such license with said clerk and the payment of the license fee as therein provided, the clerk shall issue to the applicant a license for the days specified in the application, which license shall be signed by the Village President and counter signed by the said clerk, and shall authorize the person receiving the same to exhibit or operate in said Village during the days specified.
