ORDINANCE #17 - Amendment

RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS

<u>Section 1.</u> It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any dog owned by such person to run at large at any time in the Village of Cochrane.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Village Marshal or Dog Catcher to seize, impound or restrain any dog found running at large in the Village of Cochrane, and he shall notify the owners personally or by mail, if such owner be known, or if such owners can be ascertained with reasonable effort; and if unknown, then the Marshal or Dog Catcher, shall post written notice in three public places in the Village of Cochrane, within 48 hours after having taken such dog into his possession, giving a description of the dog, stating where it is impounded and the condition for its release; or shall publish such notice with description, in want ad section of local paper. If after 10 days the owner does not claim such dg, such officer shall dispose of the dog in a proper and humane manner. All dogs shall be properly cared for and sheltered while impounded.

Section 3. Any person violating Section 1 of this ordinance shall forfeit to the Village of Cochrane a sum of ten dollars and the costs of the action for its collection. The owner of any dog seized, impounded or restrained under Section 2 of this ordinance shall pay to the Village of Cochrane, the sum of \$1.00 for each day thereof as and for the expense of keeping such dog, and the said Marshal/or Dog Catcher shall not release such dog to the owner until said sum is paid.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
