ORDINANCE #18

USE OF PUBLIC DUMPING GROUND

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF COCHRANE, BUFFALO COUNTY, WISCONSIN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

AN ORDINANCE TO GOVERN AND REGULATE THE USE OF PUBLIC DUMPING GROUNDS.

<u>Section 1.</u> No person shall leave or deposit garbage or refuse of any kind on any public dumping grounds owned, leased or maintained by the Village of Cochrane, unless such garbage or refuse is deposited at least one hundred feet from any public highway.

<u>Section 2.</u> Any person violating Section 1 of this Ordinance, shall forfeit to the Village of Cochrane a sum not exceeding Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
