ORDINANCE #37

KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK IN VILLAGE

"To take the place of Ordinance #33

"An Ordinance to Govern the Keeping and Raising of Livestock and other animals, including Cattle, Horses, Goats, Hogs, Sheep, and Mink"

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane Do Ordain as Follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> No person shall keep, raise or maintain pigs, hogs, goats, cattle, horses, sheep, or mink at any time within the Village limits of the Village of Cochrane, except as hereafter provided.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. This Ordinance shall not apply to any prior existing and established uses for as long as such usage shall be continuously operated on the premises or buildings actually used for such purposes prior to the passage of this Ordinance but shall prohibit any expansion of such prior existing usages either as to area in use or as to extension of buildings presently in use.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane may upon application thereto, permit the temporary usage of specified areas for the keeping and raising of pigs, hogs, goats, cattle, horses, sheep or mink within the Village limits if in its discretion it deems it necessary to prevent hardship and if such area is at such time sufficiently far away from any platted or improved property.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall forfeit to the Village of Cochrane a sum not exceeding Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) each day during which a violation of any provision of this Ordinance continues shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
