## **ORDINANCE #48**

## SNOWMOBILE ORDINANCE

The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

- 1. Any person may lawfully operate a snowmobile upon the Village of Cochrane street known as Burlington Street on that section of said street between Cedar Street and Seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) Street and may operate upon that section of Seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) Street between Burlington Street and Main Street. Said street sections are hereby designated as a snowmobile route.
- 2. Any person so operating a snowmobile on the above authorized section of Burlington or Seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) Streets shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicle traffic.
- 3. Any person operating a snowmobile on a designated snowmobile route may operate on any Village Street only to proceed directly between their place of residence and the snowmobile route and the most direct route must be used.
- 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of Sections 2 or 3 of this ordinance may be required to forfeit the sum of \$100.00, plus the costs of prosecuting said action.
  - 5. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
