## WHAT IS RECYCLABLE?

### **PLASTICS (all #1-7)**

- plastic containers
- tubs
- bottles
- jugs
- detergent containers

### **GLASS JARS & BOTTLES**

- jars & bottles of any color

### **CARDBOARD/PAPER**

- newspapers, shiny inserts
- magazines and catalogs
- any type of corrugated boxes
- pressed paper & office paper
- soda, pizza, & beer boxes
- egg cartons & phone books
- mail, junk mail & envelopes
- cereal, cracker, & snack boxes
- toothpaste, soap & detergent boxes
- cards, gift wrap (no tissue or foil paper)
- shredded paper (place in paper bag)

### **CARTONS- FOOD & BEVERAGE**

- milk cartons (dairy, soy, almond)
- juice, soup, broth & wine cartons

### **METAL**

- aluminum, tin, steel cans
- empty aerosol cans, empty paint cans/lids
- aluminum foil, pie plates, containers (cannot be soiled with food)
- wire clothes hangers
- christmas lights, extension cords, electrical wiring (no coaxial cable)

## **Other Non-Recyclable Items Accepted:**

- \* Refrigerated Appliances (Mondovi, BBC&M, Nelson sites)
- \* Tires (Mondovi, BBC&M, Nelson sites)
- \* Florescent Light Bulbs (Mondovi, BBC&M, Nelson sites)
- \* Mattress and Furniture (Mondovi, BBC&M, Nelson sites)
- \* Fees apply to the disposal of these items. See Buffalo County Recycling website for additional information and for a complete list of items accepted

### **Free Items Accepted:**

Scrap metal (Mondovi and BBC&M sites)  
Used oil (Mondovi, BBC&M, Nelson sites)  
Oil Filters (Mondovi and BBC&M sites)

### **Electronics Recycling\***

Computer Items, T.V.'s and Other Electronics are accepted at the Mondovi and BBC&M sites during normal recycling hours.  
\*Please note that there are recycling charges associated with many of these electronics items. See Buffalo County's Recycling website for more details.

### **Demolition & Construction Materials**

Accepted at the Mondovi and BBC&M sites only. Prices may vary, please contact site for cost

### **Household Hazardous Materials:**

Accepted only during County "Clean Sweep" events which are held as grant funding comes available. Information will be posted on the Buffalo County Recycling Website. For Other Questions Contact: LaCrosse County Hazardous Waste Collection Center (608)785-9999

Note: Latex paint cans can be allowed to dry out and disposed of in the trash. Dried plastic paint containers can be recycled.

**Unused Medications can be disposed of on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Courthouse in the designated medical disposal box.**
