

ORDINANCE #79A

**PARKING & PLOWING DURING A SNOWFALL**


The Village Board of the Village of Cochrane, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

1. Whenever there is a snowfall accumulation of one (1) inch or more, it shall be unlawful to park on Main and Fifth Streets after 5:00 A.M. until such time as snowplowing and snow pickup operations are complete.
2. Whenever any motor vehicle is illegally parked on Main or Fifth Street, and it prevents or impedes the removal of snow from the street, said vehicle may be towed away at the owner's expense along with a fine according to the Village's current fee schedule.
3. Businesses and residents are not to use their own equipment to plow snow on Village streets. They will be held liable if an accident or damage were to occur as a result.
  - A. There will be a fine, according to the Village's current fee schedule, for failure to abide by such restrictions.
  - B. Additional expenses incurred to remove such snow placed in the street by the property owner will be billed to the property owner.
4. Businesses and residents are not to plow or shovel any snow onto other's property. If there is too much snow for your space, it is your responsibility to have it hauled away.
5. Businesses and residents are not to plow or shovel any snow onto Village streets; except sidewalks without boulevards. You will be held liable if an accident or damage occurs as a result.
6. This Ordinance supersedes all previous Snow Emergency Ordinances (54, 54A, 73, and 79).
7. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
