### **What is an Agricultural Enterprise Area?**

-An Agricultural Enterprise Area, or AEA, is a part of the Department of Agriculture's Farmland Preservation program in which large tracts of land are preserved for continual agricultural promotion and development.

### **What can an AEA do for me?**

- Landowners located within an AEA are eligible to sign up for new Farmland Preservation Agreements, in which you would receive \$5 per acre under contract, in return for keeping your land in agricultural production for another 15 years.
