TOWN OF ARCADIA ORDINANCE 2021-02

STATE OF WISCONSIN Town of Arcadia, Trempealeau County

The Town Board of the Town of Arcadia, Trempealeau County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.07 (8), Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance. This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the installation of stop signs on town highways in the town as follows:

A. Three-way stop signs shall be placed at the intersection of River Valley Road and Cross Road at which traffic will stop before entering or crossing.

The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall erect stop signs as provided in this ordinance on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

This ordinance is effective on September 25, 2021.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
