

TOWN OF ARCADIA DOG LICENSING POLICY

REGULATION AND LICENSING OF DOGS. (1) **DOG LICENSE REQUIRED.** It shall be unlawful for any person in the Town to own, harbor or keep any dog more than five (5) months of age without complying with the provisions of this section and §§174.05 through 174.10, Wis. Stats., relating to the listing, licensing and tagging of same.

Any person owning, harboring or keeping a dog and the occupant of any premises on which the dog remains or to which it customarily returns daily for a period of ten (10) days is presumed to be harboring or keeping the dog within the meaning of this section

RABIES VACCINATION REQUIRED: It shall be unlawful for any person to keep a dog in the Town which is over five (5) months of age and has not received a rabies vaccination as required by §95.21(2)(f), Wis. Stats. No license will be issued without documentation of up-to-date rabies vaccination.

DOG LICENSE FEES: Fees shall be established as follows:

Unneutered male/female	\$ 8.00
Neutered male/female	\$ 3.00

Kennel License (5 to 12 dogs) - \$35.00 (over 12 dogs, each additional dog tag is \$3.00)


Owners of 5 or more dogs must contact the Trempealeau County Zoning Department for more information regarding the kennel ordinance (715)538-2311, ext. 223


TRANSFER PROHIBITED: No person shall use for any animal a license receipt or license tag issued for another animal.


LATE FEES: The Town Treasurer shall assess and collect a late fee of \$5.00 per dog from every owner of a dog five (5) month of age or older if the owner failed to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year or within 30 days of acquiring a licensable dog, or if the owner failed to obtain a license before the dog reached licensable age.


The Town Treasurer will issue late notices to those who fail to license their dog(s) by April 1. Failure to pay after the notice may result in a \$500 fine or imprisonment for up to 60 days or both. (Wi Statute 174.15).


