Tax Collection Information

Please mail your tax payments to: Connie Loose, Treasurer, W368 River View Road, Chilton, WI 53014. Questions, call 920-428-4648. PLEASE make checks payable to: TOWN OF RANTOUL. You will be able to see that your payments are processed by going on the Calumet County website, www.co.calumet.wi.us. Click on "Tax Information" for 2024, enter the "Parcel ID" or "Street Number" and "Street Name" and click "FIND NOW". By selecting an item from the dropdown by "Select Detail", you will be able to look up your taxes, assessments, and other information.

Town of Rantoul Dog Licenses

All dogs in the Town of Rantoul shall be licensed and have all required vaccinations. Please have your dog vaccinated before applying for a license. Charges for licenses are \$3.00 for spayed or neutered, and \$8.00 for others. A late fee of \$5.00 shall be assessed to the owner of each dog 5 months of age or older who fails to obtain a license by **April 1**st. Licenses are issued by the Town Treasurer, Connie Loose. Please mail your proof of vaccination when applying for this license. **Sending the dog license fees along with your property tax payments would be appreciated.** NOTE: If a person neglects to pay a dog fee on his dog, his claim for dog damage will not be paid.

Garbage/Recycling

The charges for garbage and recycling totes in 2025 will be as follows: Garbage: \$180/90 gal. and Recycling: \$45.00. You will find these charges listed as "RECY" and "REF/GARB on the tax bills. Winter Plowing

Plowing snow across town roads is prohibited. It creates a dangerous situation for traffic and safety hazards for all those who travel that road. As property owner, you are responsible for the plowing being done on your property-even if you are paying someone else to remove the snow for you. Wisconsin Statute 346.94(5) states that no person may place or cause to be placed upon a highway any substance that is or may be injurious to any vehicle. A pile of snow certainly fits this description. Wisconsin Statute 346.95(3) allows a penalty of \$50 for each offense.

Cleanup of Roads

Fees for manure and/or harvesting cleanup on roads by Town equipment and personnel have been set at \$300.00 fee per call plus \$100.00 per hour from the time the equipment leaves the Town Shop until the time the equipment returns to the Town Shop, including truck cleanup.
