Calumet County and the participating municipalities of the City of Brillion, Villages of Hilbert and Potter, and the Towns of Brillion, Brothertown, Charlestown, Chilton, New Holstein, Rantoul, Woodville, have collectively undertaken the process of updating and combining our comprehensive plans into a single cohesive document. The 2045 Plan made significant changes to the previous municipal plans that are consistent with Wisconsin State Statutes 66.1001.
